

# FISH MOSAIC PLATE

**Contents:** One paper plate  
Six strips of coloured paper  
One googly fish eye

**You will also need:** Protective covering for your table  
Scissors  
PVA liquid glue, small pot and brush



## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut the strips of paper into approximately 1.5cm square tiles and sort into coloured piles.
2. Brush glue around the rim of the plate, a small section at a time, and place dark blue tiles on top with a small gap in between.
3. Now do the same with the light and dark yellow tiles around the fish, you may have to trim some to fit. Again, doing a small section at a time so that you don't end up stuck to the plate!
4. Next is the fish. Decorate this using the rest of the tiles alternating light and dark and highlighting the fins. There is no need to leave gaps and you can arrange the tiles so that they look like fish scales. I found it helped to practice on a dry piece of paper, and no glue, first to get an idea of how they would look.
5. Leave the plate to dry.
6. Once it is dry, brush over the whole plate with a watered-down mix of glue, add the eye and again leave to dry. You may need to place a book (not too heavy) on top of the plate when the edges are dry to level it out
